Association Training Day Saturday 13th October

The Association runs two training days each year, one in the Spring and one in the Autumn. The Autumn course is based in Wotton under Edge, with ringing taking place at various towers in the area, and it is focused on more advanced methods. The Spring course is devoted to simpler methods and because of the large demand it has two centres, at Tewkesbury and Cirencester. The ringing towers selected usually have fairly easy going bells, so the students don't have to struggle to get used to them whilst trying to concentrate on the method.

Some members from the Rural Branch took part in this year's Autumn course. There were just two students (myself included) and at least two helpers. I found the day very useful – an opportunity to focus on one method for a few hours, ringing it with experienced ringers who weren't thrown off course by my mistakes, and with someone standing beside me to put me right when I went wrong.

Most people who go on these courses find them helpful, whatever level of ringing they are at. I thoroughly recommend you make the effort to go on one. I think you will enjoy it. Don't be intimidated by the thought of having a lot of good ringers about. They are not there to criticise, they want to pass on some of their skills and, in my experience, often have useful little tips about something I'd never thought of before.

Information about the Spring course will be sent to towers in January/February, so look out for it
